



COVID-19 Contact Tracing Information Sheet

Contact Tracing

Contact Tracing will occur if a student, teacher, or staff member has a positive COVID-19 diagnosis.

CONTACT TRACING FOR EXPOSURE OUTSIDE OF SCHOOL

- No contact tracing is needed if the individual has not been in school or has participated in a school organized activity for at least 48 hours. However, the parent or guardian must contact Greene County Public Health.
- If an individual has been in contact with any student, teacher or staff member of the district, contact tracing needs to be performed and you must contact Jeff Eyrich at 937-767-7224 Ext. 3018.
- The district will report name, address and phone number of the positive case to the Communicable Disease Nurse at Greene County Public Health

CONTACT TRACING FOR EXPOSURE AT SCHOOL

- All classrooms, buses and elementary lunch periods will have assigned seating to assist in contract tracing procedures.
- If an individual has been in contact with any student, teacher or staff member of the district, contact tracing will be preformed by the district.
- The district will report the name, address, and phone number of the positive case to the Communicable Disease Nurse at Greene County Public Health. The Communicable Disease Nurse or another Disease Investigator will be in touch with the positive case and Contact Tracers will be in touch with the contacts of the positive case.

When Can My Child Return?

Please keep your student at home if they are COVID-19 positive, have been identified as a close contact, or have COVID-19 symptoms. Follow the guidance of the public health department or your healthcare provider. Isolation and quarantine timelines may be extended depending on individual cases.

POSITIVE COVID-19 TEST WITH SYMPTOMS/SUSPECTED COVID-19 WITHOUT TESTING

- Fever-free without medication for 24 hours; and
- Other symptoms have improved; and
- At least 10 calendar days have passed since the symptoms first appeared.

POSITIVE TEST WITHOUT COVID-19 SYMPTOMS

- At least 10 calendar days have passed since the positive test results

QUARANTINE-GENERAL EXPOSURE

- Occurs in classroom
- All parties wearing mask and at least 3 feet apart
- NO quarantine required

QUARANTINE-CLOSE CONTACT

- No mask or social distancing
- Quarantine required for 10 days after last exposure IF occurred in classroom
- Quarantine required for 14 days after last exposure IF occurred in home or sports participation
- 10 and 14 day quarantines may be reduced with PCR Test

PCR TEST

Quarantine may be limited to 7 days with the student returning to school on the 8th day, IF:

- PCR Test is administered 5 days after exposure to a COVID positive individual;
- The student is asymptomatic; and
- The PCR results are negative.

Monitoring for symptoms should continue for a total of 14 days.
