



COVID-19 Daily Checklist & Exposure Reporting

Daily Home Screening Checklist

Students should be screened by a parent/guardian at home each day before entering the school or the bus. The following symptoms indicate a possible illness, which may decrease your child's ability to learn and also puts them at risk for spreading illness to others. **Please check your child for these symptoms each day.**

- Does your child have a temperature of 100.4 degrees or above?
- Does your child have a sore throat?
- Does your child have a new uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing (for students with chronic allergic/asthmatic cough, a change in their cough from baseline)?
- Does your child have diarrhea, vomiting or abdominal pain?
- Does your child have a new onset of severe headache, especially with a fever?
- Has your child had close contact with a person who has a confirmed case of COVID-19?
- Is anyone in your household sick and getting a COVID-19 test or waiting on the results of a COVID-19 test? If so, please have all family members stay home until results are received.

If you've answered YES to any of these questions, KEEP YOUR STUDENT HOME.

Please notify the school office of the reason for their absence. Contact your healthcare provider for further guidance.

Thank you for your willingness to help us maintain the health and safety of our students and staff.

Reporting Positive Case/Exposure

All exposure and positive COVID-19 cases must be reported within 24 hours to the school district. If your child has tested positive for COVID-19 or has come into close contact with a person who has a confirmed case of COVID-19, please keep your child at home and report the positive case or exposure by calling the school and asking to speak with the building nurse or Jeff Eyrich. They will assist you in next steps.

COVID-19 EXPOSURE OUTSIDE OF SCHOOL:

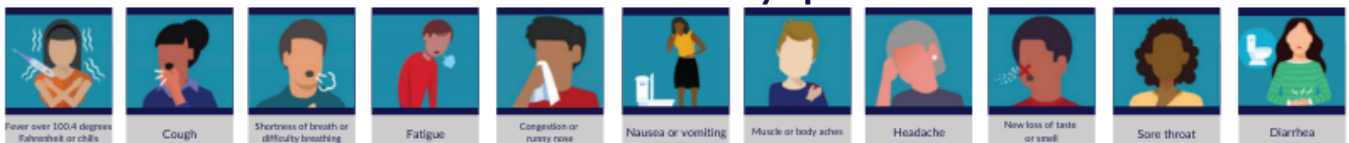
- Parents/guardians must contact the school within 24 hours of exposure and/or a positive COVID-19 test result.
- Contact Greene County Public Health for further directions regarding isolation and quarantine guidelines.

COVID-19 EXPOSURE AT SCHOOL:

- Students, teachers and staff members must contact Jeff Eyrich at 937-767-7224 Ext. 3018.
- Once reported, the district will follow the COVID-19 health and safety procedures to ensure all individuals involved are provided guidance to decrease additional exposure.

Email communication will be sent to all students/families and district employees directly impacted. Reference our *Contact Tracing Information Sheet* for more details. Any positive case/quarantine will continue to be reported every Friday on our website.
